With reference to the mail 1st cited, the Coordinator, Spoken Tutorial, IIT Bombay, informed that Spoken Tutorial Project is a Project of the National Mission on Education through ICT (NMEICT), funded by MHRD, Govt. of India. Spoken Tutorial is an audio-video tool that teaches Open Source Software. Through active Self-learning method, students learn a software in short, simple steps without the help of a domain expert on campus, in lab hours and even at home. Learning is offline, without the need for Internet. Spoken Tutorial Project has officially partnered with 97 State Affiliating Indian Universities and 10 lakh + students have been trained till date, and the project is actively working with many Technical Universities across the nation.

Further, the Coordinator, (ST), IIT Bombay, requested the University for the following:

1. JNTUH to appoint a Central Coordinator (CC) who will interact on behalf of the VC / Registrar with the Spoken Tutorial IIT Bombay Coordinator (team).
2. JNTUH to Issue periodical (semester-wise) Circular / Notification to Colleges (Constituents / Affiliates / Autonomous). Majority of the Technical Universities across India issue a circular every semester. ST team will help with the content, if required.
3. Conduct an awareness event on Spoken Tutorials inviting all affiliates. A special resource person from Spoken Tutorial IIT Bombay will be sent for the same. A date for the awareness event can be decided by mutual agreement.

4. Mention this course in CSE department Time Table as e-resource for learning. (Sample Time Table (of Osmania CSE and Anna Uni CSE) is enclosed). Other departments too can mention our courses in TT print. This will help us motivate the affiliates to initiate the program.
5. Identify / appoint 1 Faculty as Coordinator per University Department for easy implementation in University Departments and in constituent College too.
6. Nodal Center concept: In order to oversee the successful implementation of the project, JNTUH can identify 1 potential College per district who can act as a Spoken Tutorial Nodal Centre, which in turn can act as a Nodal for other Colleges in that District.
7. The Nodal Officer shall send monthly or bi-monthly progress report to the Registrar via the Central Coordinator. The same report shall be shared with the Spoken Tutorial IIT Bombay team.

Later, during the next academic year, JNTUH can explore possibilities to include Spoken Tutorial courses as reference material in the Curriculum.

In this connection, the University constituted a Committee to examine the above proposal vide reference 2nd cited. Based on the recommendations of the Committee an item was placed in the XXIV Standing Committee of the Academic Senate.

As per the XXIV Standing Committee of the Academic Senate under item No.4, vide reference 4th cited, you are requested to implement the Spoken Tutorial Project through Partnership with IIT, Bombay, and to appoint a Coordinator to interact with the Spoken Tutorial, Training Coordinator, IIT Bombay. There is no MoU and there is no financial commitment on the part of the University.
