

It has at present 3500 students, 165 teaching and 230 non-teaching staff members. GRI is a nationally and internationally recognized institute for its contribution to rural development. Duly recognizing its monumental contributions, the Institute was accredited with Five star status in February 2002 and again re-accredited with "A" Grade in September, 2010 by NAAC. The Institute has also been categorized as an 'A' grade Deemed University by the MHRD appointed committee in 2013.
