- ▶ Collections are hierarchically located below the Community or Sub-community



Collection in DSpace

- ▶ Collections are **hierarchically located below the Community or Sub-community**
- ▶ Collections are **nothing but containers for Items**



Collection in DSpace

- ▶ Items **can ONLY** be submitted in **the Collections**



Collection in DSpace

- ▶ Items **can ONLY** be submitted in **the** Collections
- ▶ Collection **can be created by** DSpace administrator **and** Community administrator

- ▶ **By default, published** Items are **publicly visible**
