- 1 By default, LibreOffice will be pre-installed in Ubuntu Linux OS.
- 2 If not, please follow the instructions to install LibreOffice manually.
- 3 To follow the installation procedure, you need to be connected to the internet.
- 4 Locate the tutorial *LibreOffice Suite Installation on Linux OS* under the LibreOffice Suite Installation series.
- 5 This tutorial explains how to install LibreOffice on Ubuntu Linux OS.
- 6 At 01:03 the tutorial explains how to download LibreOffice from the website.
- 7 At 02:40 the tutorial explains how to download LibreOffice 4.4.4.8. Instead, download LibreOffice 6.3.6.2 from the following URL: <u>https://downloadarchive.documentfoundation.org/libreoffice/old/6.3.6.2/deb/x86_64/LibreOffice_6.3.6.2_Linux_x86-64_deb.tar.gz</u>

 - b. for 32-bit OS: https://downloadarchive.documentfoundation.org/libreoffice/old/6.3.6.2/win/x86/Lib reOffice_6.3.6.2_Win_x86.msi
