



1 The procedure to install LibreOffice on Linux OS

1. By default, LibreOffice will be pre-installed in Ubuntu Linux OS.
2. If not, please follow the instructions to install LibreOffice manually.
3. To follow the installation procedure, you need to be connected to the internet.
4. Locate the tutorial LibreOffice Suite Installation on Linux OS under the LibreOffice Suite Installation series.

9. If you are able to open LibreOffice on your machine, then this means that installation is successful.
10. LibreOffice needs an installed Java Virtual Machine (JVM).
11. Download JVM from `https://java.com/download`
