Bootstrap from CDN link

- ▶ Content Delivery Network (CDN) **links are used to include Bootstrap in a webpage**
- ▶ **It delivers a cached version of Bootstrap's compiled CSS and JS to the file**



Bootstrap from CDN link

- ▶ It reduces the loading time



Bootstrap from CDN link

- ▶ **It reduces the loading time**
- ▶ Webpages **with** CDN link **always require** internet connection
