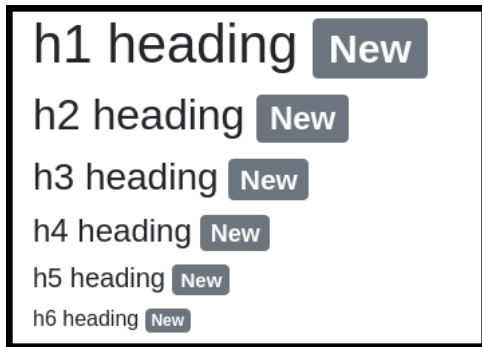


Badge

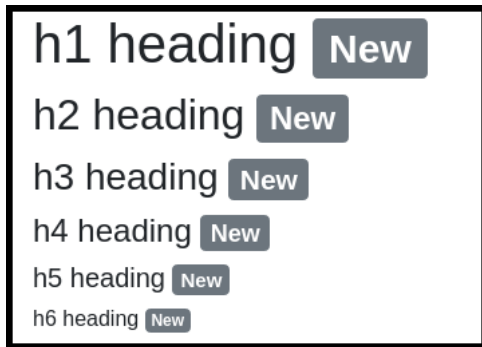
- ▶ **Badge is used as a labelling component as well as to provide counters**

- **Size of the badge is set according to the immediate parent element**



Badge Classes

- ▶ `.badge` class is used to create a **basic** badge



Badge Classes

`.badge-primary`

`.badge-secondary`

`.badge-success`

`.badge-danger`

`.badge-warning`

`.badge-info`

`.badge-light`

`.badge-dark`



Badge Pill

- ▶ `.badge-pill` class is used to make the corner of the badge more rounded
