**To answer a question in PAR format of story telling, the steps we need to follow are:**

- **The first step:** You need to know who you are telling your story to.
- **The second step:** You need to understand what information they are looking for.
- **The third step:** You need to think about the experience you want to share.
- **The fourth step:** Your experience must communicate the information they are looking for.
