



## 1 The procedure to install Firefox on Ubuntu Linux OS

1. By default, Firefox will be available on Ubuntu Linux OS.
2. If not, follow the below mentioned instructions.
3. To follow the installation procedure, you need to be connected to the internet.
4. You must have Synaptic Package Manager installed on your machine.
5. If not installed, please install Synaptic Package Manager using Ubuntu Software Center.

### 1.1 The procedure to install Firefox

1. On Ubuntu 11.04 and higher,
  - (a) Press the Window key on your keyboard to open Dash Home.
  - (b) Type Synaptic Package Manager.
  - (c) Click on the Synaptic Package Manager option.
2. Enter your password.
3. Click on OK.
4. In the search box type Firefox.
5. Click on the Firefox check box and click on Mark for Installation.
6. Click on Mark.
7. Finally, click on Apply.
8. Again, click Apply for installation.
9. The installation will take a few minutes depending on your internet speed.

### 1.2 The procedure to install Firefox via Terminal

1. Open the terminal by pressing Ctrl + Alt + T keys together.
2. Now in the terminal type `sudo apt-get install firefox` and press Enter.
3. Enter the system password if required.
4. It will display how much has to be downloaded from the internet and how much disk space will be occupied.
5. Type y and press Enter to confirm this.
6. This will install Firefox.

### 1.3 The procedure to check Firefox installation

1. Open the terminal.
2. Now in the terminal type `firefox` and press Enter.
3. This will open the Firefox Web Browser.

## 2 The procedure to install Firefox on Windows OS

1. Go to the website <http://www.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/all/>
2. Download the Windows installer for English (US).
3. Double-click the downloaded file to run it.
4. Follow all the instructions to install Firefox.
5. Once the installation is completed successfully, you can open Firefox.
6. To open Firefox, click on Start menu, click on All programs and then on Firefox.
